Who can be an EE&R trade pro?

EE&R Trade Pros are licensed contractors who can perform energy-efficient installations - for qualified customers - on behalf of the program.

 - 587 - Required for businesses established outside the state of California
 - 590 - Required for businesses within the state of California

This Trade Pro Participation Agreement ("Agreement") is between Eco Entertainment Inc. and (Insert Trade Pro official business name).



PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Trade Professional shall not state or in any way imply to the customer or any other person that the Trade Professional is employed or is working on behalf of SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc. SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc does not

endorse or recommend Trade Professional and does not review Trade Professional's proposals. Trade Professional must not misrepresent the nature of their role or their relationship with SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc.

2. Trade Professional shall not represent or otherwise indicate that any product and/or services provided by the Trade Professional or any third party are approved, authorized or endorsed by SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc. SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc does not endorse any products, services, or companies. SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc disclaims all liability in connection with, and makes no warranties, express or implied, regarding work performed by Trade Professional, nor shall SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc be in any way liable for any claims, damages, fines, settlements or judgements arising from or associated with Trade Professional contracts or work performed under such contracts. Trade Professional shall defend, reimburse, indemnify and hold SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc. and its current and parent company subsidiaries, affiliates, and their respective directors, officers, shareholders, employees, agents, representatives, successors and assignees harmless for, from, and against any and all claims, losses, fines, or damages of any type, including but limited to Trade Professional's act or omissions in breach of this Agreement. Trade Professional shall not use SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc name or logo in any promotional literature, advertisements or writing of any kind without the express prior written approval of SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc, which is not being provided under this Agreement.
3. Trade Professional shall comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws, rules, regulations and orders in its performance of service or work for any customer under this Agreement. All unused and

waste materials (i.e., old lamps, ballasts, etc.) should be removed upon completion of a project and the area left clean. Trade Professional shall provide customers with applicable equipment warranty information for all measures installed.

4. Confidentiality - Trade Professional shall not disclose any confidential Customer Information received from customer or from SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc (the "Disclosing Person") to any third party or entity, without Trade Professional having obtained the prior written consent of such Disclosing Person. Trade Professional agrees to use at least the same degree of care Trade Professional uses with respect to its own proprietary or confidential information, which in any event shall result in a reasonable standard of care to prevent unauthorized use or disclosure of the Confidential Customer Information. Trade Professional shall immediately notify SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc of any unauthorized breach or security incident, external or internal, that has the potential to compromise the confidentiality of Confidential Customer Information. Trade Professional's access to, use of, and disclosure of Confidential Customer Information shall be the sole responsibility of the Trade Professional. Trade Professional's obligation under this Section shall remain in full force and effect in perpetuity. Trade Professional shall cause each of its directors, officers, employees, agents, and representatives to become familiar with, and abide by, the same obligations of Trade Professional under this Section.

TRADE PROFESSIONAL CODE OF CONDUCT

In exchange for permission to participate in the Energy Efficiency and Rehabilitation Program, Trade Professional shall not:

1. Misrepresent Role/Relationship with SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc

Including but not limited to: stating in writing or

verbally that Trade Professional is an agent for Utility or otherwise 'approved' by Utility. Trade Professionals shall not use the SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc name or logo in any promotional literature, advertisements, email address or writing of any kind without the express prior written approval of SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc.

2. Misrepresent the Energy Efficiency and Rehabilitation Program.

Including but not limited to: giving a guarantee of savings, stating the program has costs to participate (and charging customers for projects).

3. Provide Fraudulent Documentation

Included but not limited to: use of white out, forgery of signatures, altering program forms, having customers sign incomplete forms, falsifying scope of work and invoices, submitting applications for measures that were not approved by the program or were not properly installed, etc.

4. Provide Poor Quality of Work/Customer Complaints

Including but not limited to: installation not complete to scope, unsafe or potentially hazardous installation, non-functioning equipment, failure to honor installation warranty, unresponsiveness to customer inquiries, unresolved customer complaints.

5. Disregard Program Guidelines

Including but not limited to: purchase and/or installation of measure(s) prior to receiving Notice to Proceed (NTP), failure to disclose "Supplemental Installation Trade Professional" (sub-contractor) on program application, sending work invoices to SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc prior to completion, submitting rebate applications prior to the installation of measures and/past participation verification.

VIOLATIONS OF THE TRADE PROFESSIONAL AGREEMENT OR CODE OF CONDUCT

Eco Entertainment Inc will maintain a log of customer complaints, issues, and other examples of non-compliance by Trade Professionals. SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc, in its sole discretion, may suspend or revoke Trade Professional's participation in any SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc program for violation of the program guidelines, program requirements and/or EE&R Program guidelines.

The termination shall be for a 1-year period (from the date of notification) unless otherwise specified. In extreme or egregious cases, SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc reserves the right to permanently terminate the Trade Professional from the EE&R Program participation and revoke Trade Professional's qualification to participate in applicable SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc programs. Additionally, all affected customers will be notified should an application be received from a suspended/terminated Trade Professional.

SoCalGas and Eco Entertainment Inc has no obligation to maintain, expand or continue the Trade Professional EE&R Program, and may terminate the EE&R Program at any time.
